Essential Duties and Responsibilities*

Position exists to facilitate the spiritual development of the students, collaboratively develop a Bible and Missions framework schoolwide, and foster a community of discipleship and service.

Education/Certification:

Bachelor's degree from accredited university, Bible college preferred Valid Texas or ACSI teaching certificate with required endorsements or training for subject and level assigned Demonstrated competency in Bible instruction

Special Knowledge/Skills:

- Knowledge of core academic subject assigned
- Knowledge of curriculum and instruction
- Ability to instruct students and manage their behavior
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills

Experience:

- 2-3 years in a teaching and/or coordinator role
- Ministry experience preferred
- Missions experience preferred

Major Responsibilities and Duties:

- Develop and implement a comprehensive Spiritual Formation program
- Oversee the development of a structured Bible curriculum with schoolwide vertical alignment and assessment
- Oversee the development of a structured Missions framework schoolwide vertical alignment and assessment
- Oversee all aspects of Chapel services (i.e., planning, scheduling, hosting speakers, etc)
- Develop chapel speaking schedule that incorporates diversity and provides an avenue for students to experience spiritual growth
- Instruct Bible classes as assigned
- Work with area churches to coordinate speakers and resources for students
- Work with area churches to foster a strong relationship between HCA, churches and HCA families
- Speak in chapel as necessary
- Provide spiritual guidance to students and refer them to counseling when appropriate
- Actively engage in the life of our student body by being present at campus events
- Coordinate and occasionally conduct parent education nights

Student Growth and Development:

- Conduct ongoing assessment of student achievement through formal and informal testing.
- Assume responsibility for extracurricular activities as assigned. Sponsor outside activities approved by the campus principal.
- Be a positive role model for students; support mission of HCA.

Classroom Management and Organization:

- Create classroom environment conducive to learning and appropriate for the physical, social, and emotional development of students.
- Manage student behavior in accordance with Student Code of Conduct and student handbook.
- Take all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials, and facilities.
- Assist in selecting books, equipment, and other instructional materials.
- Compile, maintain, and file all reports, records, and other documents required.
- Perform related duties as assigned by supervisor
- Maintain compliance with all company policies and procedures

Communication:

 Establish and maintain a professional relationship and open communication with parents, students, colleagues, and community members.

- Participate in staff development activities to improve job-related skills.
- Comply with state, district, and school regulations and policies for classroom teachers.
- Attend and participate in faculty meetings and serve on staff committees as required.
